


#### Total Bankruptcy Cases Filed Nationwide Calendar Years 1980 - 2021









#### 2019 - 2022 1H New Bankruptcy Filings - All Chapters








## 2022 YTD New Bankruptcy Filings - All Chapters













## 2017 - 2022 YTD New Bankruptcy Filings - Chapter 11 + SubV Commercial








## 2020 - 2022 YTD New Bankruptcy Filings - Chapter 11 + SubV Commercial










#### 2022 YTD New Bankruptcy Filings - Chapter 11 SubV Commercial








## 2020 - 2022 YTD New Bankruptcy Filings - Chapter 11 vs. 11 SubV
